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Request for Interpretation of a Standard Procedure

Purpose/Subject

The purpose of this Standard Operating Procedure is to define the process for volunteer-submitted requests for interpretation of the language in NSF Standards. NSF reserves the right to charge a reasonable fee for the processing of interpretation requests.

Procedure

- 1. The requestor (NSF staff or external user) obtains a request for interpretation form (Attachment 1) from the NSF Online Workspace (NOW) or from an NSF Standards staff member.
- 2. The requestor completes the request for interpretation form, including the Standard impacted, the section of the standard in question and a clearly stated suggested interpretation or question for consideration. The request for interpretation form shall be submitted to the JC Secretariat.
- 3. The Secretariat, in consultation with the JC Chair, shall determine if the interpretation may be issued by the Secretariat or if at the JC Chair's request the JC should consider the request.
- 4. The JC Chair will advise the Secretariat within 30 days what action(s) will be taken. The Chair has the following options:
 - Agree that the requestor's interpretation is consistent with the intent of the JC.
 - Disagree with the Interpretation and provide an explanation of the intent of the JC for the specified section.
 - Refer the request to the JC for consideration.
- 5. The Secretariat shall provide the interpretation in writing to the requestor either as a response in the request for interpretation form or in a written letter.
- 6. The interpretation shall be made publicly available on the NOW and included in the Interpretations Annex of the standard document, until revision of the document makes the interpretation no longer necessary.
- 7. If the requestor is not satisfied with the interpretation provided by the Secretariat, the requestor may submit an Issue Paper for consideration by the JC at any time.

The Secretariat of the appropriate Joint Committee will respond within 30 days of receipt of the interpretation form advising whether the submitted interpretation reflects the intention of the Joint

Committee or not. If dissatisfied with the interpretation, the requester may file an Issue Paper for further consideration of the matter by the full Joint Committee.
